



Before Joint Replacement Surgery: A Final Checklist



Se	t up your equipment at home and practice using it.
	bel all of your equipment with your name if you are bringing these items to e hospital (walker, crutches, dressing equipment).
Ar	rrange a ride to and from the hospital.
	crange for an adult to stay with you or be nearby for 24 to 48 hours after aving the hospital, if possible.
Pa	ck a small bag with:
0	Basic toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, hair brush, etc.)
0	loose fitting clothes to wear home
0	shoes/slippers with non- slip soles
0	credit card information for items such as hospital TV rental
Re	emove all jewellery and piercings.
Cl	ean your skin as instructed by the Pre-Admission Clinic nurse.
Bring the following to the hospital:	
0	your BC Services Card / BC Care Card (personal health number) and Photo
	Identification (such as a driver's license)
0	Hospital Identification bracelet (if you got one from the laboratory)
0	any medicines that the Pre-Admission Clinic asked you to bring
0	your breathing machine (CPAP machine) or dental device, if you use one
0	your ice machine, if recommended by your surgeon
